

A magnificent setting on the River Teign


A fabulous location from which to explore the rugged beauty of both Dartmoor and the spectacular coastline with miles of safe, sandy beaches.

Out and about

Just a few of the beautiful towns and cities within easy reach of Devon Valley ...

Torquay

Iconic palm trees, busy harbour and international marina could fool you into thinking you were on the Mediterranean. Make time to walk up the steps of Royal Terrace Gardens and take in the amazing sea views across the bay which are magnificent especially at night, with the lights reflecting onto the sea. There's so much going on in Torquay that one trip may not be enough. Meet the seals, penguins and otters at Living Coasts, take a sightseeing boat trip around the bay, or discover Torre Abbey and its 800 years of history told through talking statues and animated dinner plates! www.englishriviera.co.uk/torquay

Exeter

Exeter is the county town of Devon and is a great place to spend a day. A beautiful Roman walled city that seamlessly mixes ancient and modern, you can wander through the cobbled streets and squares that surround the 15th Century Exeter Cathedral and you'll suddenly find yourself in a stylish, modern high street, with cutting-edge designer boutiques, award-wining restaurants and art galleries dotted amongst all the shops you'd expect from a 21st Century shopping centre. You can also take a tour around the magnificent Exeter Cathedral or climb the north tower for some spectacular views of the city. www.heartofdevon.com/exeter

Teignmouth

Just across the River Teign from Shaldon, Teignmouth town has more than its fair share of history, as well as a picturesque seafront complete with a Victorian pier. Teignmouth was the last place in England to be invaded by foreign forces. In 1690, French forces came ashore and set fire to the town, destroying more than half of it. You can find out more about this and other aspects of the town's history at the Teignmouth & Shaldon Museum, on the appropriately named French Street. There are two distinct sides to Teignmouth – the sea front and the harbour side. It's this beautiful contrast and the fact that everything is within easy reach that makes the town so special. www.englishriviera.co.uk/ places-to-visit/south-devon/teignmouth

Dartmoor

Dartmoor is the largest and wildest area of open country in Southern England, and it really feels like it. With rivers, dramatic Tors and rolling countryside, Dartmoor is one big adventure playground with something for everyone. Nothing is more popular on Dartmoor than it's wild ponies, so make sure you take the time to look out for these beautiful animals. Dartmoor also boasts a variety of cycle routes, both on and off road, and also horse-riding, climbing, letterboxing, geo-caching or kayaking for more active pursuits. www.dartmoor-npa.gov.uk









Beaches to Visit

Spoilt for choice! - just some of our magnificent local beaches

Shaldon Beach

The nearest beach to Devon Valley, Shaldon beach has the lot – great facilities and plenty of water sports. Located at the mouth if the River Teign, it's a gently sloping mix of sand and shingle that levels out at the river estuary. Because of its location and the way the sands have formed, it's also perfect for a number of water sports including sailing, fishing, swimming, canoeing and rowing.

Teignmouth Town Beach

Only a short drive from Devon Valley or catch the ferry from Shaldon to Teignmouth, the town beach itself is a long one so you don't need to worry about the crowds, even during the summer. Perfect for families and lots of traditional beach activities like catching sand eels and exploring rock pools. Just a stones throw from the beach is Teignmouth's award winning "The Den" – a fantastic childrens' outdoor play area.



Ness Beach, Shaldon

With a backdrop of magnificent red cliffs, the Ness beach is known to have been used by smugglers in the past. Some think that the tunnel used to access the beach today was built by them, hence it's name Smugglers Tunnel. Whatever it's original purpose, it's a novel way to get to the beach, with it's dark entrance and windy path through the heart of the cliff ending with a wonderful view down onto the beach as you exit at the other end.

Dawlish Warren

If you're looking for a quality beach just a few miles from Devon Valley, Dawlish Warren is hard to beat. It's won the Blue Flag Award nine times Natural Beauty. The beach is one and a half miles long, flanked by distinctive sand dunes and an internationally recognised nature reserve and there's always something going on, either on the sands or nearby.


